**\*COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS**

## Rules & Information

- 🚫 All boaters must register at the harbormaster office and pay docking fees upon arrival.
- 🚫 Stays are limited to **three nights in, 5 nights out.**
- 🚫 Bathroom access from 9am-9pm. (Bathrooms cleaned & sanitized hourly). **No key code access for after hour use.**
- 🚫 **One boat per pedestal. NO RAFTING off other boats.**
- 🚫 **No congregating in groups of 10 or more. No tent/canopy set ups in the park/seating inlets.**
- 🚫 Quiet hours are 11:00pm-6:00am as per city ordinance.
- 🚫 Boaters must pay daily. If planning a multiple night stay, the boaters can pay the lump sum upfront but will not be permitted to pay for at the end of a stay.
- 🚫 Any boater who has docked for more than 2 hours and hasn't submitted payment, will be subject to being towed at the owner's expense.

### \*Daily Fees:

25' & Under	\$10
26'to 40'	\$15
41' & Over	\$20
Commercial Boats	\$30

*\*2 hours of free transient docking is allowed for dining and shopping downtown at the discretion of the harbormaster.*

### Overnight Fees with Electric & Water:

25' & Under	\$25
26' to 40'	\$30
41' & Over	\$35
Commercial Boats	\$45

### Overnight Fees Without Electric & Water:

25' & Under	\$20
26' to 40'	\$25
41' & Over	\$30
Commercial Boats	\$45

*Power is based on one plug per boat. Additional fee will be charged for additional power at daily or overnight fee. Check out time is 11am.*

## Rules & Information (continued)

- ⚓ **The City is not responsible for security of any boat or personal possessions.**
- ⚓ **Any dogs or pets must be leashed and under owners' control. Pets must be kept on boats during concerts and special events.**
- ⚓ **Glass containers are prohibited**
- ⚓ **Garbage must be properly disposed of in receptacles. There is to be no repair of boats or discarding of construction materials in the park.**
- ⚓ **Disorderly conduct or excessive noise are prohibited, and are grounds of removal from the park/docking area.**
- ⚓ **Firearms and fireworks are prohibited.**
- ⚓ **All walkways and seating areas must be kept clear and open for the public. Tents, grills, and personal items cannot be set up in the public dock seating areas.**
- ⚓ **Fueling of boats is not permitted in the park.**
- ⚓ **No dumping or pump outs permitted.**
